STAY ORDER

On December 27, 2018, the government filed a motion for a stay of the briefing and/or discovery deadlines in light of the lapse of federal appropriations for the Department of Justice (docket entry no. 36). In light of the foregoing, the Court **GRANTS** the government’s motion for a stay. Proceedings in this matter shall be stayed until Congress has restored appropriations to the Department of Justice. At such time, the parties shall **FILE** a joint status report informing the Court of the restoration of Federal appropriations and stating their views on the schedule for further proceedings in this matter.
