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## ORDER

Pending before the court is defendant's unopposed motion to enlarge the United States' time to reply to plaintiffs' response to the motion to dismiss in light of lapse of appropriations, filed January 16, 2019. Defendant's reply is due by January 31, 2019. Due to the partial lapse in appropriations that began on December 22, 2018, and affects the Department of Justice, defendant requests an extension of 60 days past the restoration of funding to the Department of Justice in which to file its reply. This is defendant's second request for an extension, though appropriations for the Department of Justice lapsed three days after the court granted the first extension. Plaintiffs' do not object.

For good cause shown, defendant's motion is GRANTED. Defendant shall file its reply within 60 days of restoration of funding to the Department of Justice.
