## ORDER

The court is in receipt of the plaintiff’s February 27, 2019 unopposed motion to modify the case caption in the above-captioned case to reflect plaintiff’s new name, “Blue Cross Blue Shield of North Dakota.” According plaintiff’s motion, on January 1, 2019, “Plaintiff legally changed its name from ‘Noridian Mutual Insurance Company’ to ‘Blue Cross Blue Shield of North Dakota.’” Plaintiff’s motion also states that, “Noridian Mutual Insurance Company and Blue Cross Blue Shield of North Dakota are one and the same domestic, nonprofit, mutual insurance company,” and that there “has been no transfer of Plaintiff’s interest in this case to any other person or entity.” According to plaintiff, Blue Cross Blue Shield of North Dakota “retains the rights it seeks to enforce in this action and remains the real party in interest.” Plaintiff notes in its motion that, “[d]efendant’s counsel does not oppose this request.” Plaintiff’s unopposed motion to modify the case caption is **GRANTED**. The case caption in the above-captioned case is modified to reflect plaintiff’s new name, “Blue Cross Blue Shield of North Dakota.” The Clerk’s Office is **DIRECTED** to take notice of plaintiff’s new name, “Blue Cross Blue Shield of North Dakota,” and to update the docket in the above-captioned case to reflect this change.
