ORDER

On June 27, 2018, the parties jointly requested that the Court not enter a Rule 54(b) judgment at this time and continue the stay in this case until the Federal Circuit issues its final mandates in the Land of Lincoln and Moda Health Plan consolidated appeal, and through the time for the final deposition of any petition for writ of certiorari that may be filed before the U.S. Supreme Court.
