Dear Judge Grimm,

Today, courts in three districts issued preliminary injunctions against the Department of Homeland Security's (DHS) Public Charge Rule.

First, in *New York v. U.S. Department of Homeland Security*, No. 19-cv-7777, and *Make the Road New York v. Cuccinelli*, No. 19-cv-7993, the Southern District of New York entered a nationwide preliminary injunction prohibiting DHS from implementing or enforcing the Public Charge Rule. See ECF Nos. 109, 110, No. 19-cv-7777; ECF Nos. 146, 147 No. 19-cv-7993 (S.D.N.Y. Oct. 11, 2019).

Second, in *Washington v. U.S. Department of Homeland Security*, No. 4:19-cv-5210, the Eastern District of Washington also entered a nationwide preliminary injunction prohibiting DHS from implementing or enforcing the Public Charge Rule. See ECF No. 162, No. 4:19-cv-5210 (E.D. Wash. Oct. 11, 2019).

Finally, in *City and County of San Francisco v. U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Service*, No. 19-cv-4717, *California v. U.S. Department of Homeland Security*, No. 19-cv-4975, and *La Clinica de la Raza v. Trump*, No. 19-cv-4980, the Northern District of California issued a preliminary injunction prohibiting DHS "from applying the Rule, in any manner, to any person residing (now or at any time following the issuance of this order) in San Francisco City or County, Santa Clara County, California, Oregon, the District of Columbia, Maine, or Pennsylvania, or to anyone who is part of a household (as defined by the Rule, 8 C.F.R. § 212.21(d)) that includes such a person." See ECF No. 120 at 92, No. 19-cv-4975 (N.D. Cal. Oct. 11, 2019).

Plaintiffs submit the above-referenced orders and opinions for the Court's consideration.
