Dear Ms. Wolfe:

Respondents file this letter under FRAP 28(j) to notify this Court of a pertinent decision in a related matter. The Final Rule at issue here has been challenged not only here, but in several other actions, including in the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Illinois. The district court there issued a preliminary injunction against enforcement of the Final Rule in the State of Illinois. *Cook County v. McAleenan*, 2019 WL 5110267 (N.D. Ill. Oct. 14, 2019).

The federal defendants have appealed from that preliminary injunction and, as they have done in this Court, sought a stay of the district court's injunction pending appeal. Yesterday, December 23, the Seventh Circuit denied the federal government's motion for a stay pending appeal (see attached order) and ordered expedited briefing.
