SCHEDULING ORDER

Kari A. Dooley, United States District Judge

The Court has reviewed the parties' Joint Rule 26(f) Report (ECF No. 31) and Supplemental Rule 26(f) Report (ECF No. 41). In light of the parties' representations in those reports, and at the Rule 16(b) Conference held on December 2, 2019, the Court orders as follows:

- The Plaintiffs shall file a motion for partial summary judgment on the issue of voluntariness on or before **March 2, 2020**.
- The Defendant shall file (1) a motion for partial summary judgment on the issue of voluntariness and (2) an opposition to the Plaintiff's motion for partial summary judgment on or before **April 1, 2020**.
- The Plaintiffs shall file (1) a reply in support of their motion for partial summary judgment and (2) an opposition to the Defendant's motion for partial summary judgment on or before **May 1, 2020**.
- The Defendant shall file a reply in support of its motion for partial summary judgment on or before **May 22, 2020**.

After the Court rules on the cross-motions for partial summary judgment, the Court will issue a scheduling order that follows the time intervals proposed by the parties in the Supplemental Rule 26(f) Report. At that time, the Court will also resolve the parties' disagreement concerning the designation and disclosure of expert witnesses.
