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### FINAL ORDER

On June 26, 2020, the parties filed a stipulation for entry of judgment to resolve the risk corridors claims of Blue Cross Blue Shield of Arizona (“BCBS-AZ”). ECF No. 18. The parties agree that the Supreme Court’s decision in Maine Community Health Options v. United States, 140 S. Ct. 1308 (2020), entitles BCBS-AZ to damages for non-payment under section 1342 of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act, Pub. L. No. 111-148 (2010) for benefit years 2014, 2015, and 2016 in the amount of \$72,567,005.93.

The Court therefore **ORDERS** the clerk to enter judgment in favor of BCBS-AZ in the amount of \$72,567,005.93 on Count I of the First Amended Complaint, ECF No. 15. The Court further **ORDERS** that Count II of the First Amended Complaint, ECF No. 15, be dismissed with prejudice.
