## ORDER

On May 12, 2020, the Court issued an Order continuing the stay in this case and directing the parties to file a Joint Status Report on or before June 26, 2020, the conclusion of the stay. Order Continuing Stay, ECF No. 18. Pursuant to that Order, on June 26, 2020, defendant filed a Joint Status Report, notifying the Court that the parties “are working together to attempt agreement on a stipulation for entry of judgment on the risk corridors claims,” and requesting “30 days within which to file a stipulation for entry of judgment.” Joint Status Report, ECF No. 19 at 1. The parties further suggested that, if they do not file a stipulation within thirty days, they file a Joint Status Report at that time proposing the “next steps in this litigation.” *Id.* Plaintiff does not oppose either request. *Id.* For good cause shown, this case remains **STAYED** for an additional thirty days. Should the parties not file a stipulation for entry of judgment within that time, the parties are hereby **DIRECTED** to file a Joint Status Report at the conclusion of the stay, on or before **July 27, 2020**.<sup>1</sup>
