ORDER

On June 26, 2020, the parties filed a stipulation for entry of judgment in the above-captioned matter (ECF No. 28).

In light of the foregoing, the Court **DIRECTS** the Clerk to **ENTER JUDGMENT** in the total amount of \$116,110,362.35.

This amount consists of the following:

1. \$42,764,728.44 to Premera Blue Cross on Count I of the first amended complaint for risk corridors benefit years 2014, 2015 and 2016;
2. \$15,063,573.52 to Premera Blue Cross Blue Shield of Alaska on Count I of the first amended complaint for risk corridors benefit years 2014, 2015 and 2016;
3. \$14,259,903.72 to LifeWise Health Plan of Washington on Count I of the first amended complaint for risk corridors benefit years 2014, 2015 and 2016;
4. \$44,022,156.67 to LifeWise Health Plan of Oregon on Count I of the first amended complaint for risk corridors benefit years 2014, 2015 and 2016.

The Court also **DIRECTS** the Clerk to **ENTER JUDGMENT** dismissing Counts II, III,

IV and V of the first amended complaint with prejudice.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
