ORDER

On June 29, 2020, the parties filed a stipulation for entry of partial judgment in the above-captioned matter (ECF No. 23).

In light of the foregoing, and there being no just reason for delay, the Clerk is **DIRECTED TO ENTER FINAL JUDGMENT** with regards to Sendero Health Plans, Inc.’s risk corridors claims, pursuant to Rule 54(b) of the Rules of the United States Court of Federal Claims. The Clerk shall enter judgment in the total amount of \$11,855,944.04 on Count I of the first amended complaint for risk corridors benefit years 2014, 2015, and 2016.

The Court also **DIRECTS** the Clerk to **ENTER JUDGMENT** dismissing Counts II and III of the first amended complaint with prejudice.
