STAY ORDER

On July 9, 2020, the Court held a telephonic status conference with the parties in the above-captioned matter to discuss how this case should proceed in light of the Supreme Court of the United States’ decision in *Maine Community Health Options v. United States*, No. 18-1023, 590 U.S. --- (2020).
