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**JOINT STATUS REPORT**

By Order of June 26, 2020, the Court directed the parties to file a joint status report by July 27, 2020, if they have not yet filed a stipulation for entry of judgment. Dkt. No. 20. In accordance with the Court's Order, the parties jointly report as follows:

The Parties continue to work together to attempt agreement on a stipulation for entry of judgment on the risk corridors claims. This process includes the exchange of information about the appropriate damages amount.
