ORDER

On July 21, 2020, the parties filed a stipulation for entry of judgment to resolve the risk corridors claims of Nancy Atkins. ECF No. 31. The parties agree that the Supreme Court’s decision in Maine Community Health Options v. United States, 140 S. Ct. 1308 (2020), entitles Ms. Atkins to damages for non-payment under section 1342 of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act, Pub. L. No. 111-148 (2010) for benefit years 2014 and 2015 in the amount of \$144,865,696.89.

The Court therefore **ORDERS** the clerk to enter judgment in favor of Ms. Atkins in the amount of \$144,865,696.89 on Count I of the Complaint. ECF No. 1. The Court further **ORDERS** that Count II of the Complaint be dismissed with prejudice.
