ORDER

On September 11, 2020, the parties in the above-captioned case filed a joint status report regarding the proceedings for the Dispute Subclass. They report that they "continue to exchange information and work to finalize language of an agreed stipulation to judgment" that will be submitted to the court supervising the subclass member's liquidation for approval, and request additional time for those efforts. The court **GRANTS** the parties' request. By **no later than Friday, October 9, 2020**, the parties shall file either (1) a stipulation for judgment or (2) a joint status report providing their position(s) regarding whether the stay should be continued and a proposed schedule for further proceedings.

In addition, in its May 29, 2020 order, the court directed the parties to file, with respect to the 2019 cost-sharing reduction class, to file a joint status report within fifteen days of the Federal Circuit's ruling in the cost-sharing reduction appeals to suggest a schedule for further proceedings. The Federal Circuit issued its decisions in those appeals on August 14, 2020, but the parties have not yet filed a joint status report. The court will enlarge the deadline for the parties to file their joint status report until **Monday, October 5, 2020**—one week after the deadline for the submission of petitions for rehearing.
