STAY ORDER

On October 23, 2020, the parties in the above-captioned matter filed a joint status report requesting that the Court continue the stay of proceedings in light of the United States Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit’s decisions in *Community Health Choice, Inc. v. United States*, No. 19-1633, and *Maine Community Health Options v. United States*, No. 19-2102 (ECF No. 25). The parties indicate that the plaintiffs in those cost-sharing reduction matters filed petitions for rehearing *en banc* regarding the Federal Circuit’s damages rulings, and that a stay of this case will provide the Court and the parties with clarity about the posture of those petitions and their potential impact on this case. *Id.* at 1–2. In light of the foregoing, and for good cause shown, the Court continues the **STAY** of proceedings in this matter until the Federal Circuit acts on the petitions for rehearing *en banc* in *Community Health Choice, Inc.* and *Maine Community Health Options*. The parties shall **FILE** a joint status report stating their respective views on whether the stay of proceedings should continue and, if warranted, a proposed schedule for further proceedings, no later than 14 days after the Federal Circuit acts on the petitions for rehearing *en banc* in *Community Health Choice, Inc.* and *Maine Community Health Options*.
