ORDER STAYING CASE

On August 24, 2020, the Court issued an Order staying this case due to the Federal Circuit’s issuance of a decision in *Sanford Health Plan v. United States*, 139 Fed. Cl. 701 (2018), and its consolidated appeals. Order Staying Case, ECF No. 12. Pursuant to that Order, on October 23, 2020, the parties filed a “Joint Status Report and Motion to Continue Stay,” notifying the Court that the insurer appellees in the consolidated appeals “filed petitions for *en banc* hearing on September 28, 2020.” Joint Status Report and Motion to Continue Stay at 1, ECF No. 13. Additionally, the parties requested that the Court “stay this case until 30 days after the Federal Circuit’s resolution of the pending petitions for rehearing *en banc*, or until 30 days after the Supreme Court’s final resolution of any petition for a writ of certiorari, whichever is later.” *Id.* For good cause shown, this case is hereby **STAYED** until 30 days after the Federal Circuit’s resolution of the pending petitions for rehearing *en banc*, or until 30 days after the Supreme Court’s final resolution of any petition for a writ of certiorari, whichever is later, at which point the parties are hereby **DIRECTED** to file a Joint Status Report.
