## ORDER

On December 4, 2020, the parties in the above-captioned case filed a joint status report regarding the proceedings for the Dispute Subclass. They report that they “have agreed upon the language of a stipulation to judgment” that will be submitted to the court supervising the subclass member’s liquidation for approval, and request additional time to obtain such approval. The court **GRANTS** the parties’ request. By **no later than Monday, January 4, 2021**, the parties shall file either (1) a stipulation for judgment or (2) a joint status report providing their position(s) regarding whether the stay should be continued and a proposed schedule for further proceedings.
