ORDER

In light of this court's recent decisions denying rehearing in *Community Health Choice, Inc. v. United States*, No. 2019-1633, ECF No. 88 (Fed. Cir. Nov. 10, 2020) and *Maine Community Health Options v. United States*, No. 2019-2102, ECF No. 67 (Fed. Cir. Nov. 10, 2020), and the

pending petition for rehearing in *Common Ground Healthcare v. United States*, No. 2020-1286, ECF No. 18 (Fed. Cir. Oct. 2, 2020) (collectively, “Related Cases”), the parties move jointly to continue to hold these appeals in abeyance until one or more of the parties in the Related Cases seeks certiorari in the Supreme Court of the United States, or the time for doing so expires.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

The motion is granted to the extent that these appeals remain stayed.
