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ORDER

The United States Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit issued its mandate on December 23, 2020, remanding this matter to the Court for further proceedings on the claims of the 2017/2018 cost-sharing reduction class consistent with *Community Health Choice, Inc. v. United States*, Nos. 2019-1633, -2102, 2020 WL 4723757 (Fed. Cir. Aug. 14, 2020). *See* ECF Nos. 133, 134. The Court is aware that, on February 19, 2021, the plaintiffs in those related appeals filed a petition for writ of *certiorari* to the United States Supreme Court seeking review to the Federal Circuit’s August 14, 2020 decision. *See* Pet. for Writ of Cert., *Maine Community Health Options v. United States* (U.S. Feb. 19, 2021) (No. 20-1162).

Accordingly, the Court **ORDERS** that on or before March 12, 2021, the parties shall file a joint status report addressing what, if any, effect the Supreme Court’s resolution of the *Maine Community* petition has on the instant remand proceedings and including a proposal for further proceedings in this case.
