ORDER

Pursuant to the Court’s January 7 and April 30, 2021 Orders (ECF Nos. 15, 16), the parties submitted a Joint Status Report providing an update as to *Community Health Choice, Inc. v. United States*, No. 2019-1633 (Fed. Cir.) and *Common Ground Healthcare Cooperative v. United States*, No. 2020-1200 (Fed. Cir.) (collectively, the “CSR Appeals”). See ECF No. 17. The parties report that, on February 19, 2021, the plaintiffs in *Community Health Choice* and *Maine Community Health Options v. United States*, No. 2019-2102 (Fed. Cir.) jointly filed a petition for writ of *certiorari* to the United States Supreme Court; on February 24, 2021, Common Ground Healthcare Cooperative filed a similar *certiorari* petition. *Id.* at 1–2.

Because the outcome of the CSR Appeals will affect future proceedings relating to the cost-sharing reduction claims in this case, the parties request that the Court enter an order continuing the stay in this matter until resolution of *certiorari* petitions in the CSR Appeals. *Id.* at 2. They also ask that the parties be ordered to submit a joint status report proposing further proceedings in this case within 30 days of the Supreme Court’s resolution of all *certiorari* petitions relating to the CSR Appeals. *Id.*
