**JUDGMENT**

For the reasons set forth in its separate Opinion and Order entered on March 10, 2021, the Court concludes that the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention exceeded the scope of its authority under Section 361(a) of the Public Health Services Act, 42 U.S.C. § 264(a), by adopting and enforcing a nationwide eviction moratorium in orders dated September 4, 2020 and January 29, 2021. Because these orders exceed the CDC's statutory authority, the Court declares that they are invalid.

Having filed its Opinion and Order in this matter, the Court terminates this case pursuant to Rule 58 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure.
