

I represent applicants in the above-captioned matter. I write to notify the Court that on June 22, 2021, respondents sent a notice to the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) titled “Temporary Halt in Residential Evictions to Prevent Further Spread of COVID-19.” See OMB, *Pending EO 12866 Regulatory Review*, <https://www.reginfo.gov/public/do/eoDetails?rrid=181412> (last visited June 23, 2021). A recent article reports that the CDC’s “eviction moratorium set to expire June 30 is expected to be extended by another month” and that “[a]n announcement could come as early as Wednesday.” See David Shepardson & Michelle Conlin, *U.S. expected to extend CDC residential eviction ban by one month—sources*, Reuters (June 22, 2021), <https://reut.rs/3d6DPVh>. In light of this development, applicants respectfully request that this Court vacate the stay order before the CDC announces yet another extension of the moratorium.
