Pursuant to the court's Order, filed June 1, 2021, directing the entry of judgment pursuant to Rule 54(b), there being no just reason for delay, and the parties' stipulation for entry of partial judgment, filed April 13, 2021,

IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED this date, pursuant to Rule 58, that the Dispute Subclass, consisting of Freelancers Co-Op of New Jersey, Inc., recover of and from the United States the amount of \$44,399,653.90 for risk corridors benefit year 2016, and the United States shall recover of and from the Dispute Subclass the amount of \$32,659,026.85, which amount includes payments from the Dispute Subclass associated with advance payment of tax credits, cost-sharing reductions, cost-sharing reduction reconciliations, federally-facilitated exchange user fees, risk adjustment program user fees, a start-up loan, and associated accrued interest, to be paid through deduction from the amount owed to the Dispute Subclass upon submission of the judgment to the Judgment Fund, with the net amount payable to the Dispute Subclass being \$11,740,627.05.
