DEFENDANT TRINITY HEALTHSHARE, INC.’S AMENDED NOTICE OF APPEAL

On May 14, 2021 Defendant Trinity Healthshare, Inc., gave notice, pursuant to 9 U.S.C. § 16(a)(1)(B) and Federal Rules of Appellate Procedure 3 and 4, and Tenth Circuit Rule 3.1, that it appeals to the United States Court of Appeals for the Tenth Circuit from the April 16, 2021 Order, (ECF No. 67), denying Defendants’ Combined Motion to Compel Arbitration (ECF No. 50), together with all interlocutory orders and rulings that produced that Order. The appeal has been docketed by the Tenth Circuit as No. 21-1187.

Pursuant to Fed. R. App. P. 4(a)(4)(B)(ii)¹, Defendant Trinity Healthshare, Inc., amends its notice of appeal to additionally and expressly include within its appeal the district court’s June 16, 2021 Order (ECF No. 91) denying Defendants’ Rule 59(e) Motion to Alter or Amend the April 16, 2021 Order (ECF No. 67). Thus, Defendant Trinity Healthshare, Inc. appeals to the Tenth
