**ORDER**


On July 13, 2021, the Court entered an Order (Doc. 102) advising the parties that it would not rule on Plaintiff’s Emergency Motion for Injunction Pending Appeal until the pending Motion for Reconsideration (Doc. 96) is fully briefed given the importance of the Supreme Court’s recent decision in *Johnson v. Guzman Chavez*, 141 S. Ct. 2271 (2021) to the resolution of both motions. The Order further advised Plaintiffs that if they did not want to await the ruling on the Motion for Reconsideration, the Court would deny the Emergency Motion for Injunction Pending Appeal based on its previous Order (Doc. 91) granting Defendants’ Motion to Dismiss. Plaintiffs were invited to file a Notice requesting such a ruling if they did not want to await the ruling on the Motion for Reconsideration and this Court’s consideration of *Guzman Chavez*. Plaintiffs have filed a Notice of Plaintiffs’ Request for Ruling on Emergency Motion for Injunction Pending Appeal (Doc. 103).
