ORDER

On February 19, 2021, Plaintiff in the instant case and the plaintiff-appellee in *Maine Community Health Options v. United States*, No. 19-2102 (Fed. Cir.) (“*Maine Community*”) jointly filed a petition for writ of certiorari to the United States Supreme Court following the Federal Circuit’s denial of a petition for rehearing *en banc* in their consolidated appeals. This Court then stayed this case, at the parties’ request, pending the final disposition of the petition as well as the petition for writ of certiorari filed in the related case, *Common Ground Health Cooperative v. United States*, No. 20-1286 (Fed. Cir.) (“*Common Ground*”). See ECF No. 51. Within 30 days of the termination of the Court’s stay of this case, the parties were to file a joint status report proposing further proceedings. See *id.*

On June 21, 2021, the Supreme Court denied Plaintiff’s joint petition, and Defendant’s conditional cross-petition, for a writ of certiorari. See Orders List (U.S. June 21, 2021). That same day the Supreme Court denied the petition, and conditional cross-petition, for writ of certiorari in *Common Ground*. See *id.* The parties, however, have not filed the required status report to date.

Accordingly, the Court hereby **ORDERS** that the parties submit a joint status report, with a request for leave to file out of time, by no later than August 16, 2021, proposing further proceedings in this matter.
