(First Request)

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On July 8, this Court ordered (Doc. 193) the parties to file no later than Friday, July 15, 2022 supplemental briefs about the impact of the Supreme Court’s recent decision in *Biden v. Texas*, No. 21-954 (U.S. June 30, 2022).

Pursuant to LRCiv 7.3, Plaintiffs Mark Brnovich, in his official capacity as Attorney General of Arizona, and the State of Arizona (“Arizona”) hereby respectfully move for a 7-day extension of time to file their brief, as well as a corresponding extension for the federal Defendants. If the Court grants the requested extension, the deadline would therefore become July 22.
